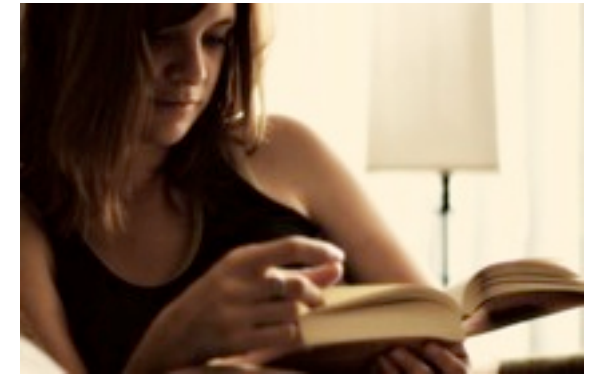


## Other Courses
