Come and join us on the 2nd to 5th Sundays of each month during the 10.45am service. We start in church and go out to our groups after about 15 minutes. On the 1st Sunday of the month everyone stays in church for our 50 minute All Age Service.

SJ Club is the name for our events with children on Sunday mornings during Church. The children are with the adults for 15–20 minutes before moving to the Stable Room for their own exciting programme. We begin with all the 3–11s together for a time of singing, Bible story, birthdays, and sometimes puppets, drama or other presentation. The children then split into age groups for further activities relating to the story or theme of the day including craft, games, discussion and talking with God. SJ Club is led by Tim Blake and a team of experienced children’s workers. On the 3rd Sunday of each month we have a ‘Special’ where instead of going to age groups, the children can choose from a variety of workshops. Workshops we have had so far include cooking, drumming, song writing, clay modelling, Christmas card making and tile smashing/tiling. We welcome you to come along to any of these.
