Take part in 'Earth Hour' on 22 March?

Earth Hour, organized by WWF, is a global grassroots movement uniting people to take action on environmental issues and protect the planet.

Engaging a massive mainstream community, Earth Hour was famously started as a lights out event in Sydney, Australia in 2007.

You can take part by simply turning off your lights for the hour to show your support (it's fine to keep on any that are needed for safety). The official time for this is 8.30pm to 9.30pm. But you could do this earlier if you have young children who want to take part.

It's even better if you can also do something positive – spend 60 minutes doing something, anything, positive for our planet and give an hour back. There are lots of ideas on the Earth Hour website - Entertainment, Wellness, Creativity, Sustainability, Nature, Food – Your 'giving an hour' can be at another time of day if that works better for you.
